Menominee Community Garden Agreement

- I will pay \$30, which will be applied to the water usage and access to the garden.
- Menominee Community Garden will provide a source of water for gardeners during the growing season.
- I will have something planted in the garden by June 15th and keep it planted all summer long.
- I will supply my own seeds, plants. Natural/OMRI approved organic fertilizers/pesticides, and tools needed for growing and caring for crops.
- I will not plant invasive or illegal plants.
- I will keep trash, spent plants, and litter cleaned from the plot as well as from adjacent pathways and fences. I will take trash with me each day when I leave.
- **I will pick only my own crops** and respect my neighbors.
- I will remain on the premise while watering, and I will not leave hoses unattended.
- I will supervise children in my care.
- I will not bring pets to the garden. Service dogs/animals are allowed.
- No smoking will be permitted in the garden.
- I will maintain my plot(s) in a clean, neat manner. I will keep weeds down in my plot. If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand I will be given one (1) weeks' notice to clean it up. After that time, it will be re-assigned and/or tilled in.
- I will have everything out of the garden by November 1st. If fall clean-up is not complete, I will forfeit my plot(s) for next year.
- I will not hold the Menominee Community Garden or the City of Menominee liable for any damage, loss, or claim that occurs in connection with use of the garden by me or my guests.
- In the event of obvious neglect of the garden plot(s) or failure to abide by the rules, the Menominee Community Garden can repossess the plots. We reserve the right to be the final judge in settling any dispute concerning the garden plot(s).
